- 5. Today, the learners went ten pin bowling and then to McDonalds, before setting up the hall in the afternoon for their much anticipated leavers' ball tonight!






















It has been a pleasure for me to teach the learners over the course of the last four years and I hope they all have an enjoyable and carefree future!
