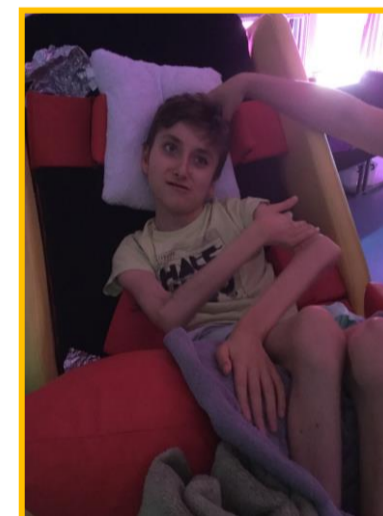
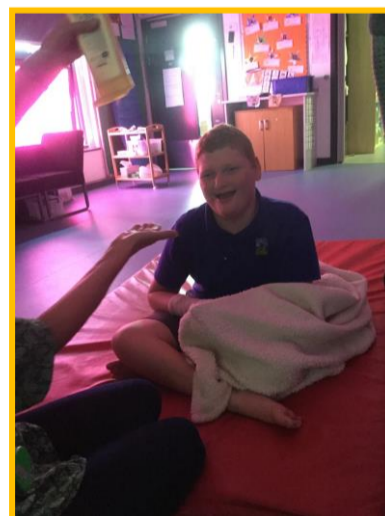
★ Class of the Week – M7★
